

Selection Policy

Policy Statement

This policy sets guidelines for the use of both selectors and riders in relation to the selection of Cycling Southland representation and representative teams for both road and track disciplines.

Purpose

To ensure that Cycling Southland has a clear selection policy that is easily accessible to eligible members.

Responsibilities

The selection panel is elected by club members at the annual general meeting.

Selectors will:

- Attend as many local/regional/national events as possible.
- Communicate with the people such as coaches as they deem necessary and appropriate for each code.
- Provide regular updates to national selectors of outstanding performances.
- Aim to provide a transparent and fair process for all applicants seeking selection.

Riders will:

- Respond to calls for Expression of Interest for events to let selectors know of their intentions;
- Inform selectors of events to be considered for as appropriate.
- Inform selectors of outstanding results and performances at regional, national and international level.
- In applying deem to be in agreement with Cycling Southland policies, especially in regards to the Travel and Rider Agreement policies.
- Be of the clear understanding that selections may change at an event due to unforeseen circumstances and must accept the selectors' decisions.

Procedures

Key Components of Selection

The following will be considered by the selection committee when selecting representatives:

- A rider's ability to meet qualification time standards (where applicable);
- Southland Championship results;
- National/international competition results;
- A rider's behaviour as outlined in the *Cycling Southland Rider Agreement* and/or from previous behavioural history when representing Southland;
- Residency.

Time qualification standards are an indication and a goal for a rider to target. Being outside the time qualification standard does not mean they will not be considered for Southland teams.

The selectors reserve the right not to fill all available positions on both track and road disciplines.

Notification and Team Announcement

A rider selected will be notified by email and/or announced via the Cycling Southland Facebook page.

Appeal Process

A rider who has not been selected in a representative team may lodge a request to the selectors via the office to be considered within 48 hours of the official team being released.

The selection committee will consider the rider's request and the rider will be notified of the decision.

Track Events Selection

National Track Championships

National Track Championships have restrictions on entries and the following criteria will be used to determine a rider's selection to the National Championships for all grades:

- Performance at Southland Track Championships;
- Previous results at national championships;
- Results and times at local/national/international carnivals;
- Rider's automatic qualification in timed events;
- Rider's ability to be competitive at national championships;
- Rider's ability to add value to the team and help others succeed;
- Rider's attendance and contribution to Cycling Southland squads and club activities over the 12 months prior to selection;
- A rider's behaviour as outlined in the *Cycling Southland Rider Agreement* and/or from previous behavioural history when representing Southland;
- Residency.

Automatic Qualification Time Standards and Maximum Event Entries.

The following is a list of automatic selection time standards in terms of the CNZ Road & Track Selection policy to gain entry to the National Track Championships. These are subject to change, any changes will be notified and the Cycling Southland Selection Policy will be amended accordingly.

Masters Events

All Master events have six (6) entries; selections will be made pursuant to the criteria set out above.

Team Time Trial Selection

All riders wishing to represent Cycling Southland in Team Time Trials shall notify the selectors of their intention. The selectors will place riders in the appropriate team based on the following criteria.

- Previous performances in Team Time Trials/Individual Time Trials.
- Recent road racing results at club/national/international level;
- Grade a rider competes in at club and national races;
- A rider’s behaviour as outlined in the Cycling Southland Rider Agreement and/or from previous behavioural history when representing Southland.

International Events Selection

The following criteria will be used to determine a rider's selection for an international competition:

- Performance, results and times at a national or international championship/carnival and/or track events in the 12 months prior to competition;
- Rider's ability to be competitive at an international competition;
- A rider's behaviour as outlined in the *Cycling Southland Rider Agreement* and/or from previous behavioural history when representing Southland.
- Competitive times in training/racing;
- For Track Events, the rider's ability to meet the following time standards:

All riders wishing to represent Cycling Southland at an international competition shall notify the selectors of their intention, and the events they wish to be considered for, by emailing the Cycling Southland Coaching Co-ordinator.

Road Events Selection

Selection Criteria

- Previous performances in National/International road events.
- Results at recent Regional/National road events.
- Results and performances at Cycling Southland Club races.
- A rider's behaviour as outlined in the Cycling Southland Rider Agreement and/or from previous behavioural history when representing Southland.

Elite & U23 Road Race and Time Trial Selection

Any rider wishing to represent Cycling Southland in this event is able to self-select but must notify Cycling Southland of their intentions, to represent and gain approval.

Other Events

For all other Cycling Southland representative teams the Selection Committee will base selections on the criteria set out in the Key Components section above.
