Junior Division Sub-Committee Travel Grant Policy

Updated December 2021

Policy Statement

Cycling Southland's Junior Division Sub-Committee provides travel grants to <u>junior club</u> riders selected for representative teams.

Purpose

To ensure that Cycling Southland's Junior Division Sub-Committee has a clear policy that is easily understood and accessible around the provision of discretionary travel grants to junior club members.

Policy Details

Rider travel grants will only be considered for North Island events NZ regional and overseas events where the rider has been selected by Cycling NZ or Cycling Southland to compete.

Applications must be applied for in writing to the <u>Junior Division Sub-Committee</u><u>selectors and General Manager</u> at least four weeks prior to the event. <u>Applications may be emailed to office@cyclingsouthland.org.nz for consideration.</u>

To be eligible, riders must stay with the representative team (if applicable) and must abide by all team travel and health & safety policies put in place.

The grants will be considered on an individual case by case basis balancing the ability of the Junior Division Sub-Committeeclub to finance the grant.

The grant amount can vary and will be considered at the time of the request by the Junior Division Subselectors and in consultation with the Cycling Southland General Manager Committee. No previous grant will act as a precedent for future grants.

The grants will be determined on the rider's commitment to the organisation, including <u>previous</u> participation in events <u>such as the King House Removal Series</u> and carnivals, plus fundraising activities, club participation and squad training sessions <u>as applicable</u>.

Two coaches will be eligible for the travel grant for national events in the North Island, which will be considered by the Junior Division Sub-Committeeselectors and in consultation with the Cycling Southland General Manager on an event basis. The team manager will be paid for by Cycling Southland.

No event entries will be paid. Payment of any rider grant is at the sole discretion of the selectors and in consultation with the General Manager.
